He has strong clinical and research interests in coronary heart disease particularly in relation to microvascular and large coronary artery spasm. These interests have evolved from his extensive postgraduate training at international institutions including, the University of the Sacred Heart in Rome with Professor Attilio Maseri, the Kyoto University in Japan with Professor Shigetake Sasayama, & Harvard University in Boston with Professor Peter Ganz. He currently supervises 12 PhD students investigating both basic and clinical aspects of coronary heart disease.
